

Lyda M. Locke Scholarship Application Process

Scholarships Available: Up to two \$1,000 scholarships annually. Scholarship winners receive a one-time award.

Sponsored by: The Locke Family

Objective:

Lyda M. Locke Scholarship awards up to two high school seniors pursuing undergraduate studies in business, finance, or banking a \$1,000 scholarship to honor the inspiration Lyda M. Locke is to her family.

Eligibility:

Must be or have been a participant in a Junior Achievement (JA) high school classroom program, graduating from a high school within Dane County, WI, and pursuing post-secondary education in the fields of business, finance, or banking toward an Associate or Bachelor's Degree. The post-secondary school must be located in the United States.

How to Apply:

To apply for the Lyda M. Locke scholarship, interested students must submit:

- 1. A completed application form.
- 2. Official high school transcript with grades.
- 3. Two letters of recommendation: One from a business person, community leader, or Junior Achievement (JA) Classroom Volunteer, and one from a teacher or school administrator.
- 4. Written essay describing how Junior Achievement programs that you participated in influenced your career planning goals. <u>Please limit your essay to 500 words</u>.
- 5. Applications submitted without all required documentation will be disqualified.

Scholarships will only be awarded to participants who are lawfully in the United States.

Method of Selection:

Applicants will be selected based on their application to the committee. Financial need is not considered. Recipients will be notified via email by: May 31, 2023.

Deadline and Submission:

Scholarship application must be received by or postmarked by April 30, 2023.
