

Going Once, Going Twice! Two JA Auction Fundraisers Inspire Success



April saw two JA Auctions bring together smiles and support for JA's work on behalf of K-12 students across Wisconsin.

In JA's Southcentral Region, the **JA Inspire Auction**, raised funds in support of K-12 programming across Southwestern and South-Central Wisconsin, including the counties of Columbia, Crawford, Dane, Dodge, Grant, Green, Iowa, Jefferson, Lafayette, Richland, Rock, Sauk, and Walworth. Featuring 44 auction items, the event saw a remarkable 94.4% increase over last year in registered bidders.
